SPACE PLANNING DIAGRAMS – AUGUST 1, 2014

Following the July Oversight Group meeting, the Space Planning Diagrams have been refined and developed. Some general comments for this presentation:

- A) As noted previously, these plans can be considered reliable “test fits” which indicate how well the requested space “fit” in the building. Whereas detailed meetings have been held with each occupant, modifications to the layout and tuning door locations, etc. will be refined with further development. The overarching goal with this presentation is to establish reasonable ‘real estate’ for Legislature, Governor, and Security as defined with SEA043. Accommodation of the Secretary of State, Auditor, and Treasurer are considered with this presentation.
- B) The 2nd and 3rd Floors are assigned to the Legislature and the layout presented has been developed in coordination with LSO and the Chief Clerks of each chamber. Again, additional refinement may be explored in the coming months. For clarity, these plans are provided with Option I only.
- C) Similarly, the Governor Suite layout is the same for each of the Options except for space assignments around the rotunda at the 1st floor.
- D) Whereas a Security Assessment Study is underway, there have been detailed meetings to strategically address the anticipated space requirements. The spaces allocated for Public Safety are considered reasonable placeholders at this time.
- E) The Herschler building, inclusive of the connector, existing building, and the planned addition, are being planned to accommodate additional needs with respect to the Legislature and Public Safety. Specifically regarding Legislature,
 - a. four Committee Rooms nominally the size of room 302 are located in the connector
 - b. session staff and shared chairman offices are located in connector
 - c. a large committee room, similar and size and function to room B63 is located in the Herschler Addition.

Additional spaces for media, Capitol Club, etc. are included in the Herschler planning.

- F) Spaces left blank (white and not labeled) are planned for restrooms, circulation, and building systems (e.g. mechanical, electrical, etc.).
- G) The numbers shown on each assigned space are tied to the attached space lists. The space lists show the approximate assignable area for each space for each option. The first number indicates the organization the room is assign to:
- 1 = Legislature
 - 2 = Governor
 - 7 = General Support
 - 8 = Public Safety
 - 9 = Elected Space for the Capitol – Space assignments expected for the Herschler are as represented in the Level I & II Report, Volumes I and III.

Note: numbers 3-6 are assigned to Elected offices and will be shown on the Herschler plans.

- H) We take this moment to apologize for the confusion on the various options presented to date. As each option requested develops the current ideas and also reconciles incorrect representations, this presentation will utilize new, distinct names. In this way we are not wrestling with confusion over current versus out-of-date representations.

FOUR OPTIONS

We understand that the direction from the Oversight Group is to develop Option E and Option B (as presented July 16).

Option E allocated space at the Southeast, Northeast, and Northwest corners of the rotunda to the Secretary of State, Auditor, and Treasurer. Option E may be summarized as

- represents the request of the Legislature
- removes space allocated to the Governor
- provides offices for the Secretary of State, Auditor, and Treasurer
- does not provide the requested conference room space desired by the Elected.

At the direction of the Oversight Group, the option has been re-drawn. Thus Option I is provided as the evolution of Option E.

Option I

- 1) Allocates space at the rotunda for the Secretary of State, Auditor, and Treasurer.
- 2) Makes the Legislative meeting room labeled "1.97 Library" available to the Elected (scheduled through LSO) anytime except during Legislative Session.
- 3) Does not impact the space allocation to Legislature
- 4) Removes Public Reception and two Conference Rooms (program # 2.81, 2.85, and 2.86) from the Governor's space allocation.

Option I is a direct response to the direction of the Oversight Group. A similar option is presented here, Option J, to endeavor to address the negative impacts to the Governor.

Option J

- 1) Allocates space at the rotunda for the Secretary of State, Auditor, and Treasurer
- 2) Makes the Legislative meeting room labeled "1.97 Library" available to the Elected (scheduled through LSO) anytime except during Legislative Session.
- 3) Makes the Governor's Conference room (program # 2.85) available to the Elected (scheduled through the Governor's office) anytime.
- 4) Does not impact the space allocation to Legislature
- 5) Removes one Conference Room (program # 2.86) from the Governor's space allocation.

Option B allocated space at the west end of the 1st floor for the Secretary of State, Auditor, and Treasurer – North and South. Option B may be summarized as

- does not impact the space allocation to the Governor.
- impacts the Legislature space allocation as follows
 - requires moving more space to the Herschler than acceptable to Legislature
 - fragments adjacencies for LSO operations
- allocates more space to Public Safety than is now considered necessary
- provides reception, offices, and conference space for the Secretary of State, Auditor, and Treasurer to provide the requested
- represents the request of the Elected and the preferred option of the Governor

At the request of the Governor, the option has been re-investigated to endeavor to reconcile the above comments. Thus Option K is provided as the evolution of Option B.

Option K

- 1) Allocates space at the west end of the 1st floor for the Secretary of State, Auditor, and Treasurer – North and South.
- 2) Allocates space at the rotunda to Legislature
- 3) Does not impact the space allocation to the Governor
- 4) Impacts the space allocation to Legislature as follows:
 - a. Moves the technology workroom & training room (program #1.88) to the Herschler.
 - b. Fragments adjacencies for LSO operations
 - c. All requested staff are accommodated within the Capitol, however some staff are shown in open workstation as opposed to the requested enclosed offices, and some workstations are smaller than desired.

Whereas Option B suggested that the Program Evaluation group, and others would need to move to the Herschler, this Option K, by making the above adjustments, does not move any staff offices out of the Capitol for Legislature.

Option K is a direct response to the request of the Governor and the Elected. A similar option is presented here, Option L, to endeavor to keep the spirit of Option B and yet address the negative impacts to Legislature.

Option L


- 1) Allocates space at the west end of the 1st floor for the Secretary of State, Auditor, and Treasurer – South only.
- 2) Allocates space at the rotunda to Legislature
- 3) Does not impact the space allocation to the Governor, except to share the Governor's Conference Room (program # 2.86) with the Elected.
- 4) Impacts the space allocation to Legislature as follows:
 - a. Fragments adjacencies for LSO operations
 - b. Some workstations are smaller than desired.
- 5) As with Option K above, by making the above adjustments, this Option does not move any staff offices out of the Capitol for Legislature.


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




GARDEN LEVEL - OPTION I

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



2ND FLOOR - OPTION I



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




3RD FLOOR - OPTION I






1ST FLOOR - OPTION J

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
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




GARDEN LEVEL - OPTION J






1ST FLOOR - OPTION K


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




GARDEN LEVEL - OPTION K


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




1ST FLOOR - OPTION L


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
