Here is the answer to your question of when electricity was put into the Capitol building. Electric Supply & Construction Company was designated as the contractor. They agreed to complete the installation of wiring, etc. on or before January 10, 1917 at the cost of \$2,825.00.

The lighting fixtures came from Beardslee Chandelier Mfg. Company, a Delaware Corporation whose principal office was in Chicago, Illinois. Cost - \$8,107.15. The fixtures were to be finished in a light brushed antique brass for the offices, in a bronze finish with green relief for the corridors and a statuary bronze finish for the House of Representatives and Senate.
